SERVICES SUMMARY

Discover scuba diving (one dive / two dives) - This is an introduction to scuba diving that beginners can take. It is not required in order to become certified as an open water diver, but if you would like to, the course serves as a way to familiarize yourself with the equipment and techniques before doing the open water course. We provide guests with their own copy of materials and at the end of the course they will receive a certificate for completion of the course. Dives are conducted both in the lagoon and out on a boat and the entire course takes about four to six hours to complete

Scuba review - PADI has introduced a scuba review program for certified divers that have spent considerable time without going on a dive. You can take this course in order to reactivate your card without taking the courses again. The main purpose is to let divers refresh their memory and get updated with new procedures. Scuba review takes about two days to complete.

Open Water Diver - This is an entry-level full diver certification for scuba diving. Course fee includes all the books, materials, certification card and other necessary items to get fully certified as a PADI Open Water Diver. This is the first course to make you an independent diver and its certification is valid for a lifetime. It allows you to go down 18 meters and the course is completed in five days

Advanced Open Water Diver - Completing PADI Advance Open Water allows you to go as deep as 30 meters. This is an introduction to specialties in diving; you do five dives with different objectives. This course takes three days to complete and requires the open water diver certification as a prerequisite.

Emergency first response - This is a basic Primary and Secondary Care Course, which teaches you to deal with marine life injuries and other major problems. It teaches you what you can do to someone that has been in an accident before emergency medical service personnel arrives and can takeover, such as CPR, setting up and monitoring oxygen. The course duration is one day.

Rescue diver - A Rescue Course is by far the most enjoyable main courses out there. It teaches you how to be a safe responsible diver and how to help others in need. It also brings the EFR course into the water and can be completed in five days.

Dive master - Dive Master is the first professional level in diving. The Dive Master course teaches you how to be a leader in diving and how to be an independent diver that can also help others in need. Once the course is completed a Dive Master is allowed to lead certified divers as a guide on dive sites and also can be an assistant to the instructor during courses. The Dive Master course is completed within three to four months.

Fun dive — Certified divers can choose from the many dive spots around Kaafu atoll. Our dive trips usually take approximately four hours to accommodate divers that choose two tank dives, however, guests can choose to go on only one dive. It takes about 30 minutes by boat to get to the dive spot and each dive lasts one hour but this depends on how fast air from the tank is consumed. Therefore, a dive could be over sooner than an hour. A surface interval (rest) of an hour is required before the second dive. The second dive is also an hour long depending on air consumption. Travel time back to Hulhumale' is roughly 30 minutes.

Snorkeling - We would offer 2 snorkeling dive spots where you could freely snorkel with a guide, while the divers are diving. Guests can snorkel for approximately three hours (taking rests as frequently as needed) while the divers are underwater.

Camera Rental – Gopro Hero 3+ and Sealife underwater cameras are also available for rent so that customers can use it while diving/snorkelling. All videos and pictures taken from the camera will be given to the guest at the end of their trip.
